There are almost 2 million ATMs in the world. Even in Antarctica there is one.

02

The world's first money transfer was made in the United States in 1918 using the telegraph.

03

The oldest bank in the world that still functions today is Banca Monte dei Paschi di Siena, which was founded in 1472 in Italy.

04

The first bank card was issued in 1951 by a small New York bank called Long Island Bank.

05

The \$100 note features Franklin, who was never President of the United States. Other dollar bills feature the faces of presidents.

06

Banknotes with the highest denomination - 1 million and 100 million pounds sterling were issued by the Bank of England, but they were only recognized for internal circulation by banks.

07

The smallest coin in the world was the Indian silver quarter, which weighed only 1.7 grams, and its diameter was 4 millimeters.

08

A million US dollars in \$100 banknotes would weigh about 10 kilograms.

09

The largest gold coin in the world was issued in 2007 by the Royal Canadian Mint. Its weight was 99.95 kg, its denomination was 1 million Canadian dollars.
