### Dinosaurs

Dinosaurs lived millions of years ago. They lived on planet Earth for about 165 million years! Dinosaurs came in different shapes and sizes, from tiny ones as small as chickens to huge giants like the Brachiosaurus, which was as tall as a building.

Some dinosaurs were meat-eaters, like the famous Tyrannosaurus rex (T-rex). They had sharp teeth and claws to catch other animals. Others were plant-eaters, like the Triceratops. These dinosaurs had flat teeth for chewing leaves and plants. Some plant-eaters had long necks to reach the leaves at the top of tall trees.

Dinosaurs weren't just brown or green like we see them in films. Scientists believe that some dinosaurs were colourful! Some dinosaurs, like birds, had feathers to keep warm.

The word "dinosaur" means "terrible lizard," but dinosaurs weren't really lizards. They were reptiles, just like today's crocodiles and turtles. Many dinosaurs laid eggs, just like birds do today. Dinosaurs lived all over the world in different places, from forests to deserts. But about 65 million years ago, something bad happened, and they all disappeared. Most scientists believe that a huge asteroid hit the Earth, causing big changes in the weather, which made it hard for dinosaurs to live.

Even though there are no more dinosaurs on our planet, we can learn a lot about them from fossils — their skeletons found in the ground. These fossils can give us information about what dinosaurs looked like and how they lived long ago.
