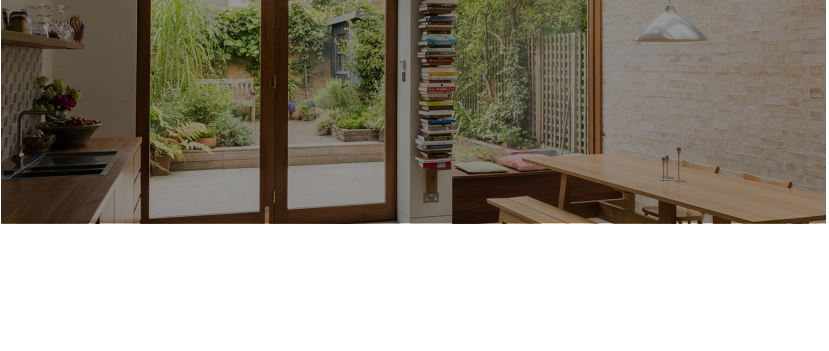

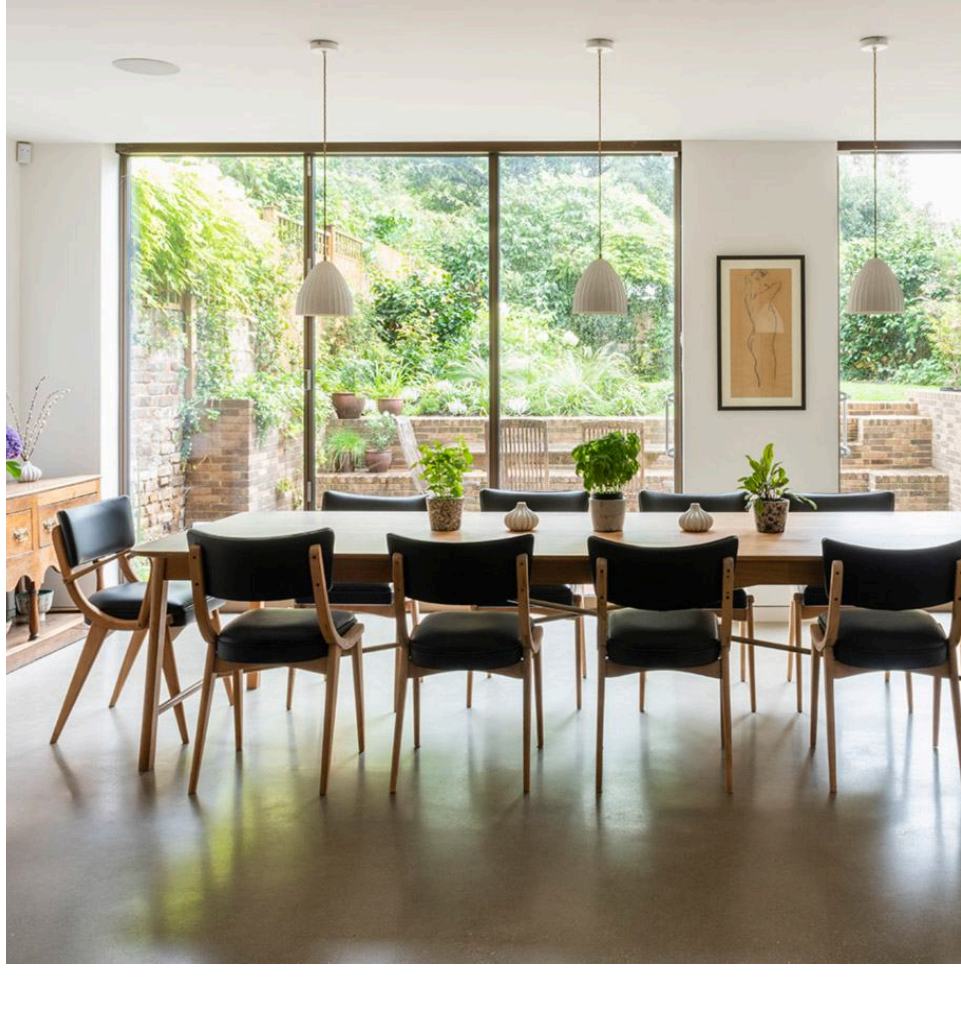
## Projects

Completed this year, this project involved the complete renovation of a detached house in Stortford which was also extended to provide an expansive, open plan kitchen dining and living space onto the garden.

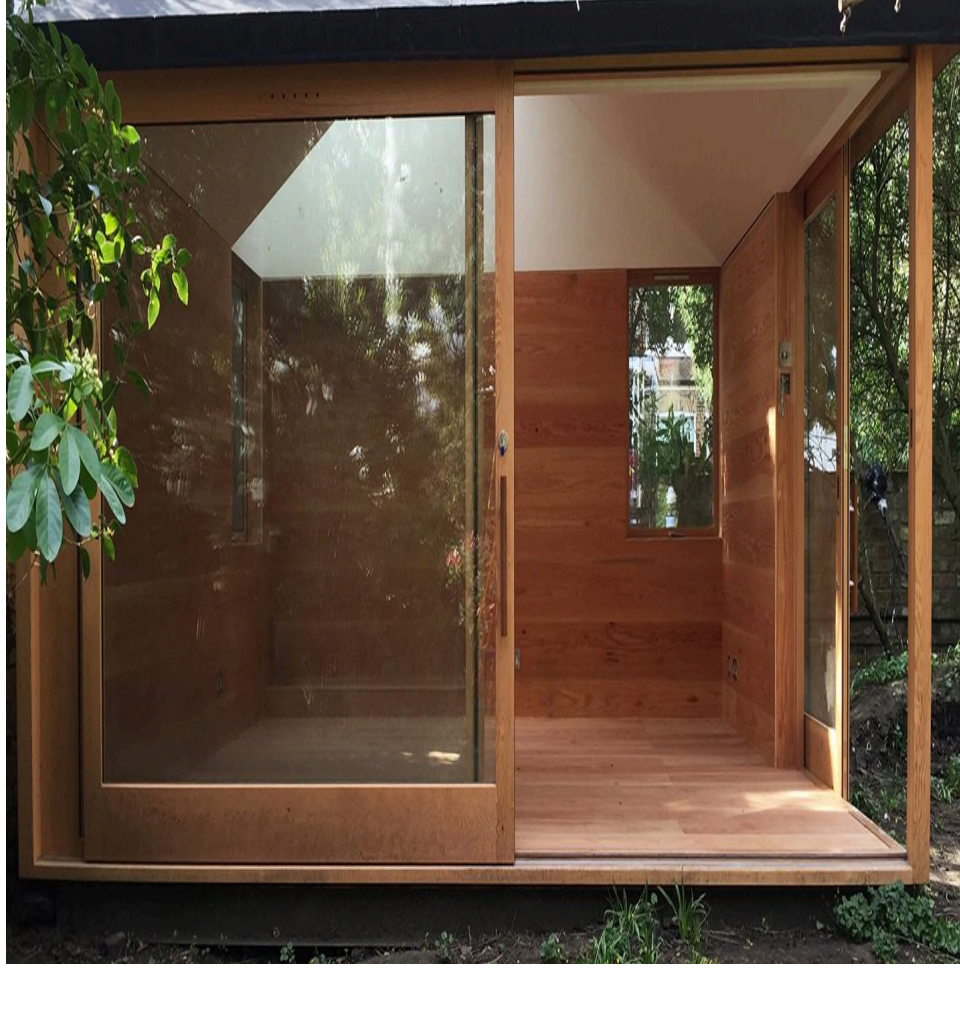

Rather than simply refurbish our house, Roman created a series of solutions that have transformed it. His brief was to improve the connection between the interior and the garden, and the end result has expectations.

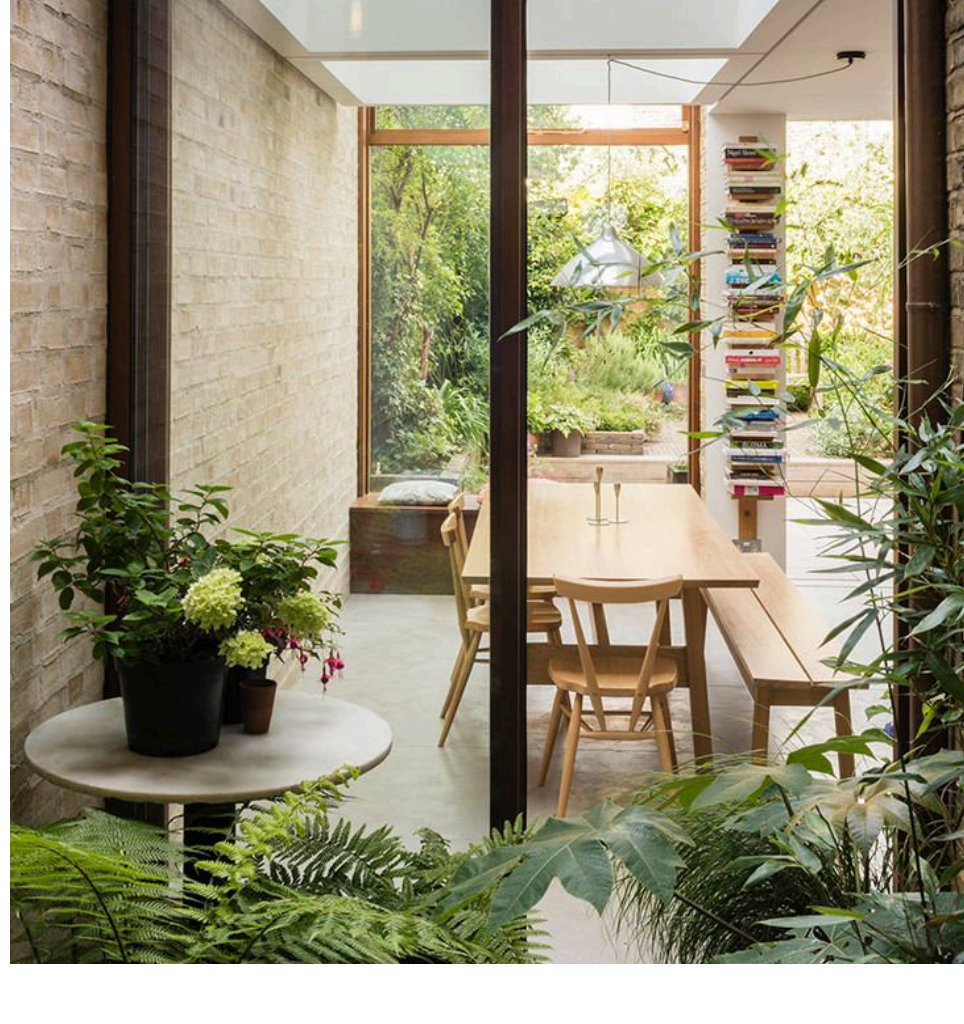
