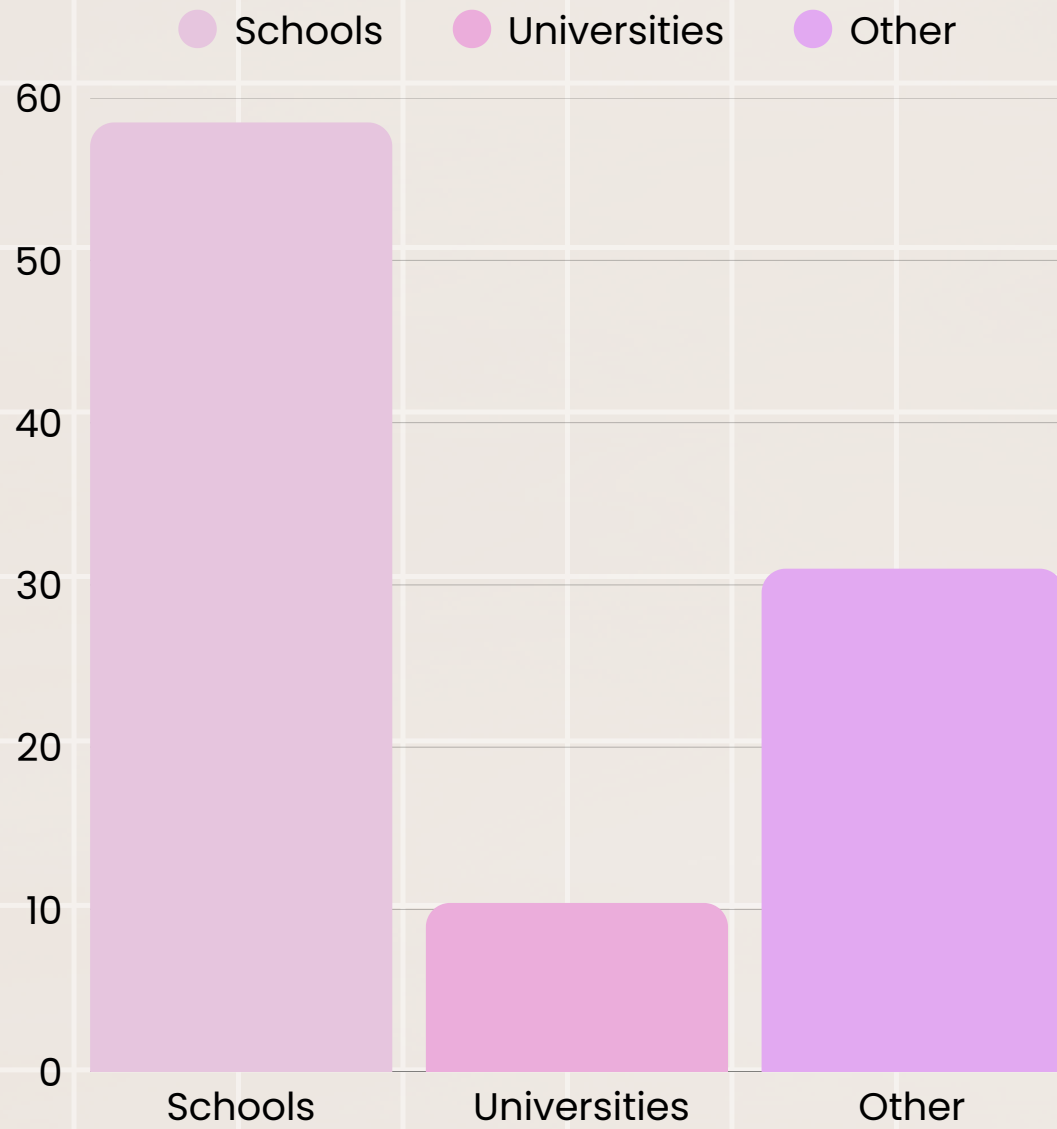


KEY PROBLEMS

Kazakhstan faces issues in funding distribution. Most resources go to school education, while higher education receives only 10.4%. There is also corruption in admissions and grading.



IMPLEMENTATION STEPS

Phase 1 — Preparation (0–6 months)

- Project team formation
- Readiness check
- Technical setup

Phase 2 — Development (6–12 months)

- Platform creation
- System integration
- Pilot testing in 3 universities

Phase 3 — National Rollout (Year 2)

- Countrywide implementation
- Staff training
- Launch of anonymous reporting tools

Phase 4 — Enhancement (2027–2030)

- System refinement
- Introduction of AI features
- Annual audits and monitoring

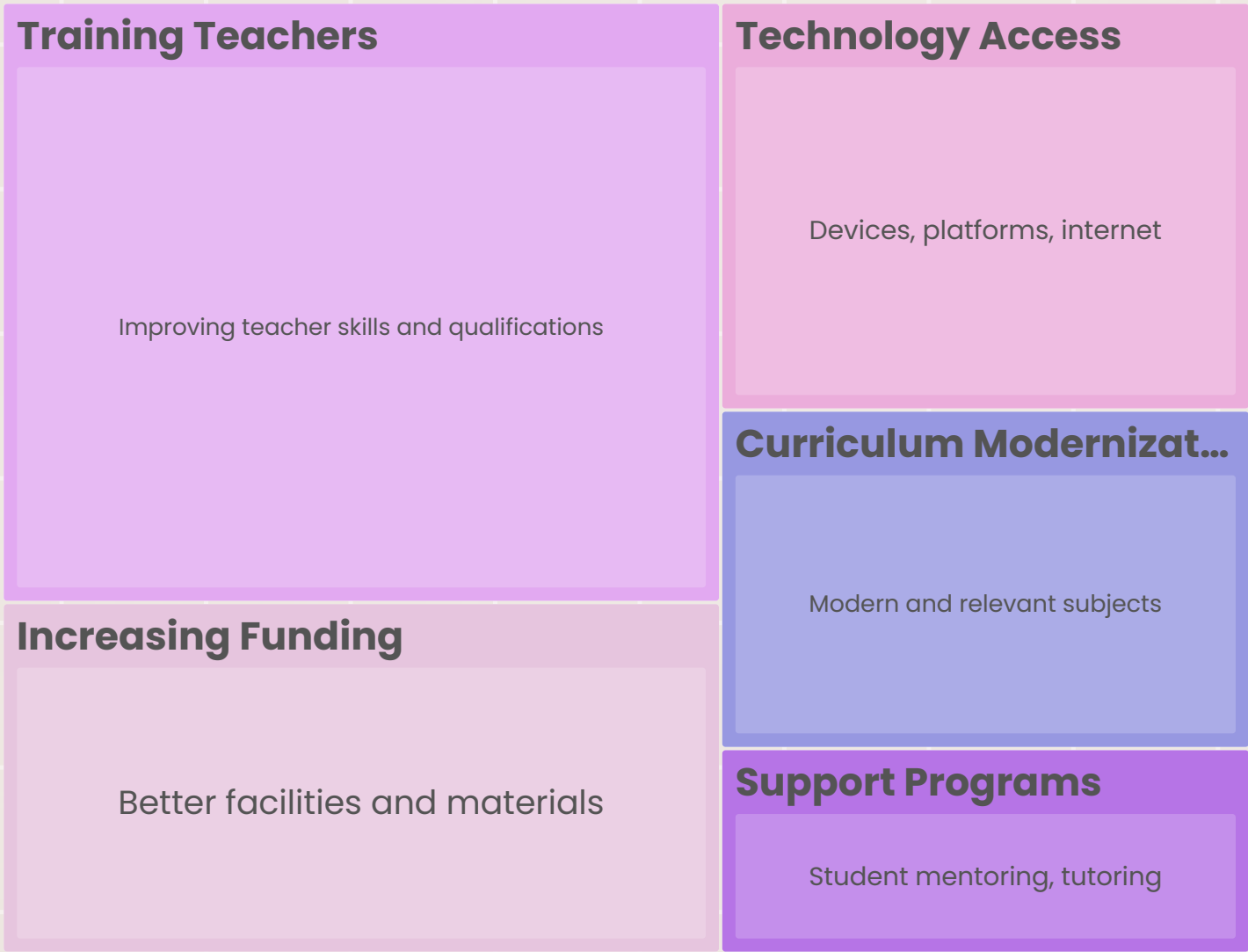
